Mission Statement

Patent Rights Restored (PRR) is an enterprise launched by Donald Boys, President of Central Coast Patent Agency, and Cynthia Lamon, a long-time legal colleague at Central Coast Patent Agency. At the most abstract level, the mission of PatentRightsRestored.com is to multiply the inventive activity of especially independent inventors on the Central Coast by at least an order of magnitude. This is to be done by driving the cost of preparing, filing and prosecuting non-provisional patent applications down to a bare minimum.

There are two broad classes of inventors: (1) those who work for business enterprises, invent in the technology of the enterprises, and are obliged to assign their patent rights to their employers, partly because the cost of preparing, filing, prosecuting and issuing the patents is paid by the enterprises; and (2) independent citizens who have ideas, and are not beholden to their employers, but who simply cannot afford to retain patent professionals to prepare, file and prosecute patent applications for their ideas. Consequently, nearly all patents are owned by corporations, and participation by individual citizens is very small.

It is the nature of every human to note problems and unmet needs, and to imagine improvements. So everyone has at one time or another contemplated an invention. But the number of people who take their ideas to the level of the test of a real patent application (not a provisional application) is woefully small, because of the complexity and cost.

If there existed an excellent guidance system by which any intelligent person could prepare, file, and prosecute in examination an excellent non-provisional patent application, and the cost for doing so were to be zero or at least a very small fraction of what patent attorneys, agents and IP firms charge, then I do believe a sizable portion of the general population would be acting on their inventions. The result would invariably be a very noticeable surge in innovation and patent

applications in the area of our focus, firstly our Central Coast. This will result in new businesses, new jobs, and opportunities for a lot of people.

This is exactly what we (PRR) are preparing to launch.

We will do this with direct seminars however often needed to drive the process for everyone who elects to participate. We will provide guidance documents and videos addressing every incremental point in the process of developing an invention and filing a patent application, and we will provide voluminous examples drawn from our own data stores of cases actually prosecuted and issued in the US and foreign jurisdictions, including as-filed Word docs of specifications and formal drawings for cases that have issued as patents.

Cynthia Lamon and I are well qualified to accomplish this, having been involved for years in preparing, filing and prosecuting thousands of patent cases in a broad range of technology, both in the US and abroad.

This concept is being presented to persons on the Central Coast who are intimately involved in technology, innovation and entrepreneurship, and is being received with hearty endorsement.
